<b>2</b> Put on some <b>music</b> . Stamp your feet, tap the table, clap your hands, and wiggle your hips to the beat	<b>3</b> Go on a <b>colour hunt</b> together. How many things can you find that are red/blue/green in 5 minutes?	<b>4</b>	<b>5</b> Ask your child to <b>name</b> as many things as possible that are: blue/green/fast/cold	<b>6</b> Pick a <b>book</b> your child knows by heart. Let your child tell you the story.	<b>7</b> Create a <b>Reading corner</b> for your child with lots of books, blankets and soft pillows.	<b>8</b> Plan a <b>Picnic</b> together. Have your child talk about what you need: food/blanket/hat
<b>9</b> Together name <b>body parts</b> and what they're used for: "This is my nose. I can smell flowers, soap and popcorn"	<b>10</b> <b>Write</b> down words that your child likes. Have him/her draw a picture next to it: dinosaur/puzzle/game	<b>11</b> Play a <b>naming game</b> . See who can name the most fruits, animals etc.	<b>12</b> Ask "What" questions: "What would you do if you lived in a zoo?" Have your child tell you and draw a picture.		<b>14</b> Make a <b>Job Chart!</b> Use pictures of simple jobs your child can do around the house: Cleaning up-cut out a picture of toys in a toy box.	<b>15</b>
<b>16</b> Make <b>animal sounds</b> together. Take turns sounding like birds/elephants/monkeys.	<b>17</b> Get out the <b>play dough</b> . Shape it into letters and numbers. Talk about what you are making.	<b>18</b> <b>Learn</b> a new word today!	<b>19</b>	<b>20</b> Play the " <b>Yes-No</b> " game. Ask questions like "Can you fly?", "Do dogs meow?"... Take turns with your child	<b>21</b>	<b>22</b> <b>Ask</b> your child what he/she did today.
<b>23</b> <b>Story chain</b> . Have one person start a story and everyone in the family adds a sentence to make a funny new story.	<b>24</b> <b>Hug</b> a Teddy Bear today. Play games with your little one and their teddy bear. Talk about what Teddy might be thinking		<b>26</b> Play " <b>Mirror</b> ." Take turns making funny faces and sounds and copying the others movements.	<b>27</b>	<b>28</b> Play a <b>Guessing Game</b> . Describe an object and have your child guess what it is.
